



Safe Shelter

Goal

To refurbish the cellar of the kindergarten of border village Nerkin Khndzoresk so that it can serve as a bunker in the case of border violence.

Project background & description

Nerkin Khndzoresk is one of Syunig region's many border villages. It is surrounded by Azerbaijan on three sides. At its closest, it is less than 600 meters from the border.

Most homes in the village have some sort of cellar. In the case of a sudden attack, residents usually take immediate refuge there. What happens if a strike or shooting takes place during school hours? While the village kindergarten has an underground space, it is old and unsafe. It doesn't have proper ventilation, toilets or doors; thus, it would not be able to serve as a long-term solution in the case that children would need to hide for more than a few hours.

To ensure the safety of the village's kindergartners and teachers, we want to support the school in renovating the cellar. Together, with your support, we will turn it into a well-equipped bunker in which the kids can stay in the case of danger. Because the bunker will be able to accommodate more than 100 people, it will also serve as a refuge for anyone in the community who needs shelter should the need arise.
